

**RULES OF THE “BOWERS CONCRETE CUP”**  
**UNDER 45kg INVITATION RUGBY TOURNAMENT 2011**

1. Squad to consist of the first 21 boys to be successfully weighed. Full names, ages and school currently attending required.
2. Team Managers must present two copies (on team sheets provided) of a complete list of the 21 boys. Players to wear the same jersey number for the duration of the tournament.
3. Boys to be **under 45kgs** at the first weigh in. No tolerance. Boys will be weighed again on the final day when ONE KG allowance (ie: **Under 46kg**) will be permitted. Only the team manager is permitted to accompany his team at the weigh in.
4. Boys not making the weight are to be crossed off the list by the weigher and signed.
5. Boys to be Form 2 or under, and to be under 13 years of age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2011.
6. Additional players (emergency circumstances only) are permitted at the discretion of the Management Committee.
7. Substitutions: Up to 6 substitutions may be made for any reason during the course of the match.
8. The hosting venue is to provide referees and organise fields. The Management Committee will provide the scales and the Official Weigher.
9. Games to be 2 x 25 minute halves.
10. Any player sent from the field will automatically miss the next competition game.
11. Any boy who is a member of the current Gwynne Shield Squad is ineligible for this competition. A player called into a Gwynne Shield Squad for 1 game could however be eligible at the discretion of the Management Committee.
12. All results to be forwarded by the host team to the Secretary within 24 hours.
13. **NO** non-permanent advertising (other than on team apparel) which is in competition with the tournament sponsor **BOWERS CONCRETE** is permitted at the venues where the tournament is being played.
14. Points will be awarded for the following: 4 for a win. 2 for a draw. 1 for losing by a margin of 6 points or less. 1 for scoring 4 or more tries in a game.
15. In the event of a tied result for either first or second place. A count back will be undertaken. This will be decided by totaling the scores of each game played during the competition, the team with the higher total will be awarded the position in dispute. In the unlikely event of a tied score, after a count back, the result will be determined by the toss of a coin.
16. Failure to observe any of the above rules will result in loss of competition points and/or disqualification from the tournament. Any dispute will be decided by the Morrinsville Bowers Concrete Cup Invitation Tournament Management Committee.
